

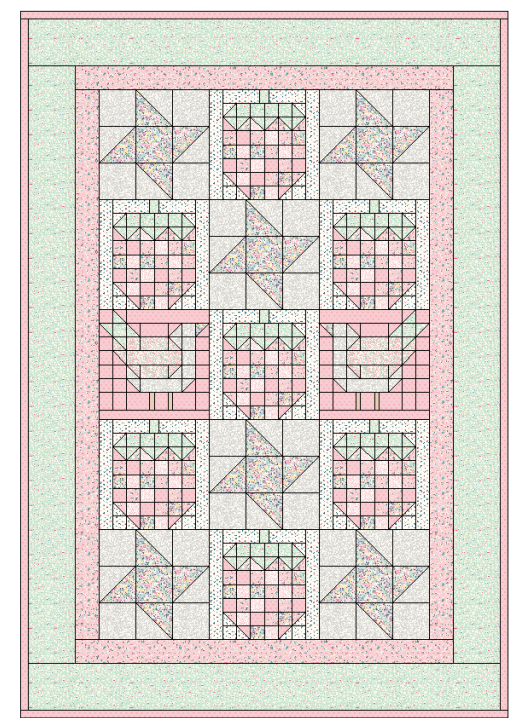

Tea Party	2 1/8 yard	04775617X
Candy Hearts *	2 3/8 yard (0.8m)	04775621X
Budding Blossom	1/4 yard (0.23m)	04775622X
Solid Brown	1/8 yard (0.12m)	Not from this collection

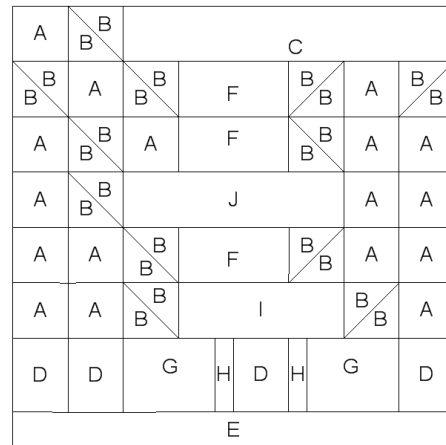
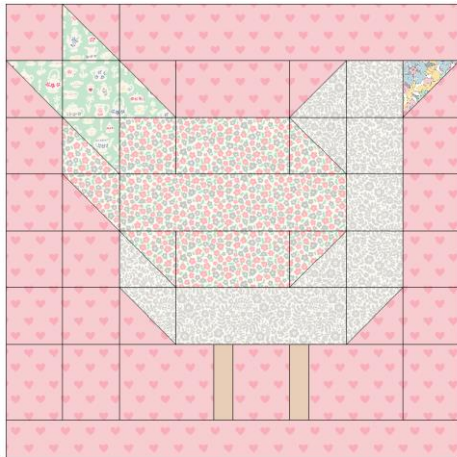

Backing Fabric

5 yards (4.57m)

Bird Block - The following instructions are for ONE bird block only
 (If you are making the quilt, cut two sets)



- 2 x 2"

Candy Hearts - cut 11

Green teacup treasures- cut 2

Budding Blossom - cut 4

B - 2 3/8 x 2 3/8"

Candy hearts - cut 8

Daisy Dance - cut 6

Budding Blossom - cut 5

Green teacup treasures - cut 4

Flowntops - cut 1

C - 9 1/2 x 2"

Candy Hearts - cut 1

D - 2 x 2 1/2"

Candy Hearts - cut 4

E - 12 1/2 x 1 1/12"

Candy Hearts - cut 1

F - 3 1/2 x 2"

Candy Hearts - cut 1

Budding Blossom - cut 1

G - 3 x 2 1/2"

Candy Hearts - cut 2

H - 1 x 1 1/2

Brown - cut 2 (not tea for two fabric)

I - 2 x 5

Daisy Dance - cut 1

J - 2 x 6 1/2

Budding Blossom - cut 1

Sewing Instructions

Sew using a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated.

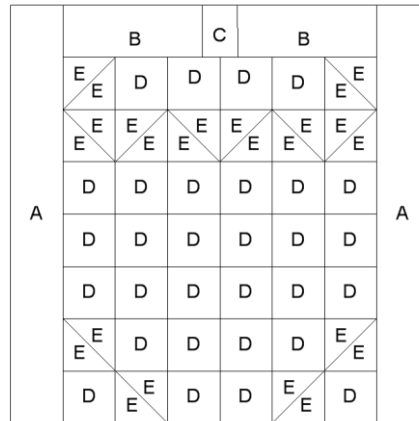
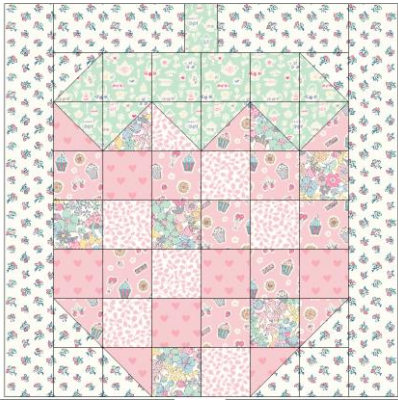
To make the half-square triangles:

Place the two B fabric squares RST, draw a diagonal line on the top square. Sew 1/4" along each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line and press open. Trim to 2" square.

Construct each horizontal row following the diagram. Press the seams on each row in opposite directions (i.e. row 1 to the left, row 2 to the right etc).

Sew the rows together starting at the top and working down.

STRAWBERRY BLOCK - The following instructions are for ONE strawberry block only (If you are making the quilt, cut seven sets)



A - 12 1/2 X 2
Heart Bouquet - cut 2

B - 2 x 4 1/2
Heart Bouquet - cut 2

C - 2 x 1 1/2
Teacup Treasures - cut 1

D - 2 x 2
Heart Bouquet - cut 2
Flowertops - cut 5
Tea Party - cut 8
Garden Trail - cut 6
Teacup Treasures - cut 4
Candy Hearts - cut 5

E - 2 3/8 x 2 3/8
Heart Bouquet - cut 6
Candy Hearts - cut 3
Flowertops - cut 2
Tea Party - cut 4
Teacup Treasures - cut 8
Garden Trail - cut 1

Sewing Instructions

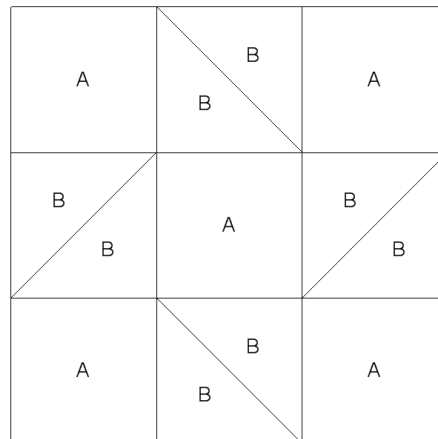
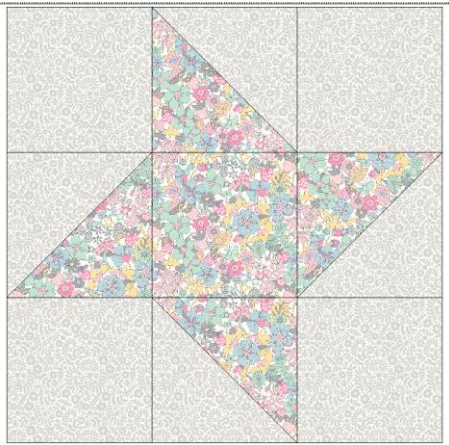
Sew using a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated.

To make the half-square triangles:

Place the two E fabric squares RST, draw a diagonal line on the top square. Sew 1/4" along each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line and press open. Trim to 2" square.

Construct each horizontal row following the diagram. Press the seams on each row in opposite directions (i.e. row 1 to the left, row 2 to the right etc). Sew the rows together starting at the top and working down. Finally, add the two vertical A strips to the sides.

STAR BLOCK - The following instructions are for ONE star block only (If you are making the quilt, cut six sets)



A - 4 1/2 x 4 1/2

Daisy Dance - cut 4
Flowertops - cut 1

B - 4 7/8 x 4 7/8
Daisy Dance - cut 4
Flowertops - cut 4

Sewing Instructions

Sew using a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated.

To make the half-square triangles:

Place the two B fabric squares RST, draw a diagonal line on the top square. Sew 1/4" along each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line and press open. Trim to 4 1/2" square.

Construct each horizontal row following the diagram. Press the seams on each row in opposite directions (i.e. row 1 to the left, row 2 to the right etc). Sew the rows together starting at the top and working down.

Border 1 = 3" finished - Tea Party

Cut 7 WOF (width of fabric) strips at 3.5", join on the bias and sub-cut as follows
2 strips 3.5" x 70.5"
2 strips 3.5" x 48.5"

Join the sides first and then the top and bottom.

Border 2 = 6" finished - Teacup Treasures

Cut 7 WOF strips at 6.5", join on the bias and sub-cut as follows
2 strips 6.5" x 76.5"
2 strips 6.5" x 60.5"

Join the sides first and then the top and bottom.

Border 3 = 1" finished - Candy Hearts

Cut 8 WOF strips at 1.5", join on the bias and sub-cut as follows

2 strips 1.5" x 88.5"

2 strips 1.5" x 60.5"

Join the sides first and then the top and bottom.

Quilt as desired and then bind.
